Trade: servant of all work

Age: 20

Sentence: 14 years

Tried: 29 May 1828, London

Offence: larceny from the person

Free by Servitude: 29 May 1842

Whilst a Convict

- ❖ In excess of 20 offences listed on her conduct record, mostly for being absent without leave and absconding.
- ❖ Spent time at the female factory in Hobart.

Colonial Life

- ❖ Married John GOLDSMITH, (transported per *Layton*) on 14 November 1836, at New Norfolk.
- ❖ Children:
